Diary of a public nuisance: The 'castle' on States

April 2020: Developer begins to clear site, compromising historic garage. Working with Supervisor Mandelman's office, CHN files a complaint with Department of Building Inspection, DBI. Weeks later, DBI cites developer for lack of multiple building permits.

May 2020: Developer guts garage. Note unique steeple (background) that matches the Castle exterior. CHN complains again about the building safety. Garage demolition ordered by DBI. Months later, garage is "red tagged" by city order.

November 2020: Developer removes structure, but leaves property wide open giving easy access to children, pets or even arsonists. Another DBI complaint is lodged.

December 2020: Fence is erected. Construction site is finally secured.
