The much-loved urban sanctuary known as AL's Park is about to receive a major face lift to return it to its former splendor. This restoration effort is being driven by a group of local CHN volunteers.

The Park (369 Corbett) is named after Al Kovalick, a 99 year-old resident of Corbett Avenue for 74 years. Over the many decades, he initiated several significant beautification projects in the neighborhood.

This “street” was once Mono Street prior to the widening of Market Street. The land belongs to the Department of Public Works, DPW.

AL's Park is cited in several San Francisco guide books and often referenced by local tour guides. Many visitors have commented on the beauty and quirkiness of the park over the years.
