Because of members and donors like you, we have:

- Maintained, improved, and beautified the character of the neighborhood by maintaining and improving its street parks—The Slope, Al's, Ord/Corbett and Merritt/Danvers
- Expended dozens of volunteer hours cleaning trash, painting benches, trash cans, watering the parks, spreading bark, and calling 311
- Increased security by reporting suspicious activity and supported safe streets
- Encouraged friendly association among neighbors through our park events
- Discussed and considered responses to issues of local and citywide concern
- Provided a forum for education and community outreach by providing the January membership survey, summarizing the data, and following up with concerns expressed

- Established a relationship with a new fiscal sponsor, Independent Arts & Media only ten weeks after the collapse of the SF Parks Alliance
